



ARMORY MINING ANNOUNCES PRIVATE PLACEMENT AND APPOINTS KLENMAN TO BOARD

Vancouver, B.C. – August 7, 2025 – Armory Mining Corp. (CSE: ARMY) (OTC: RMRYF) (FRA: 2JS) (the “Company” or “Armory”) a resource exploration company focused on the discovery and development of minerals critical to the energy, security and defense sectors, is pleased to announce a non- brokered private placement offering of up to 15,000,000 units (the “Units”) at a price of \$0.05 per Unit for aggregate gross proceeds of up to \$750,000 (the “Offering”). Each Unit will be comprised of one common share of the Company and one transferable common share purchase warrant. Each Warrant entitles the holder to purchase one additional common share of the Company at a price of \$0.065 per common share for a period of three years from the date of issuance.

The proceeds raised from the Offering are expected to be used for working capital and general corporate purposes. All securities to be issued under the Offering will be subject to a four month hold period in accordance with applicable Canadian securities laws and the policies of the Canadian Securities Exchange.

The Company is also pleased to announce that Alex Klenman, Chief Executive Officer of the Company, has been appointed as a director of the Company in place of Arjun Grewal who has resigned as a director.

The Company would like to thank Mr. Grewal for his contributions to the Company and wishes him success in his future endeavors. Mr. Grewal will continue to support the Company in an advisory capacity.
